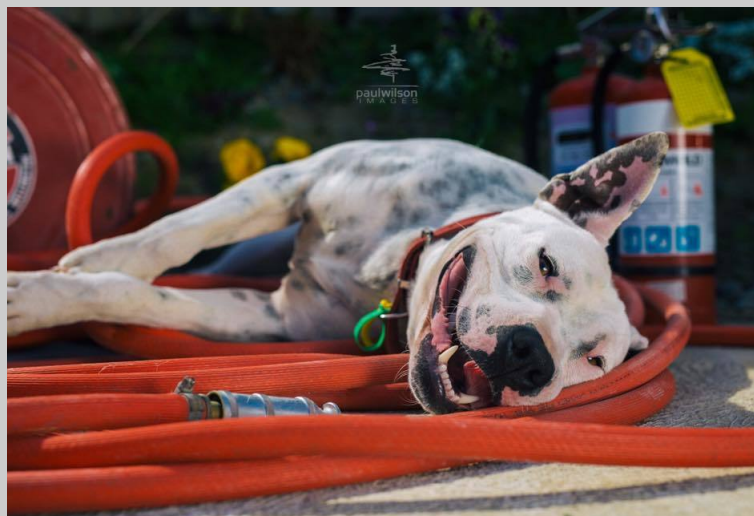
Helping you help your dog

Respect the growl: When growling can be your friend

It's understandable to be worried when our dogs behave aggressively towards other people or dogs, particularly when it isn't obvious why. The aggression may be because your dog wants to protect a resource or because they are over-excited and restricted by the lead or a fence.

But at other times they are afraid of the target of their aggression and you need to know that. Whatever the reason, that snarling is part of the dog's language and it's telling you that all is not well. Punish the growling and your dog will stop, but the attitude towards the object of his behaviour won't have changed. He's just stopped telling you. And that stops you predicting what he might do next. If you are concerned about your dog's behaviour in any way, but especially growling or signs of aggression, please contact a dog trainer or behaviourist to help you before things get out of control.
