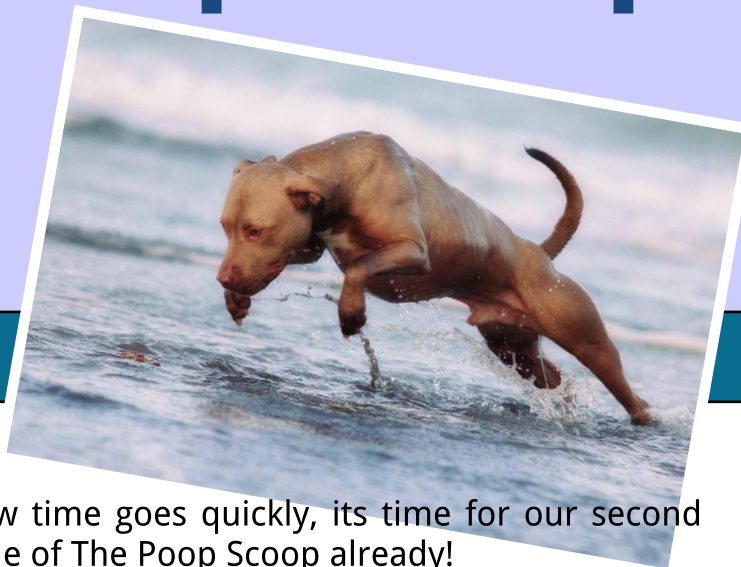

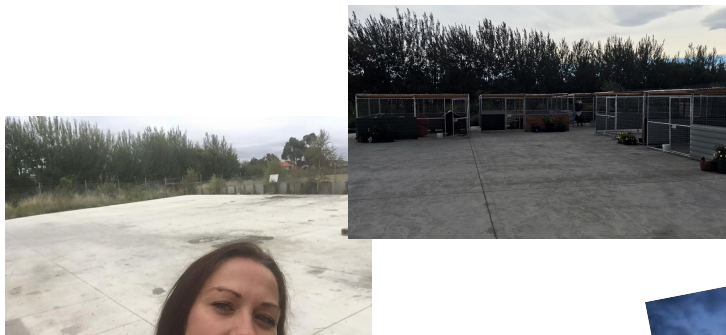
PS - no animals were harmed in my story, just my pride!

Helping you help your dog

Taking away fear 'Tackling the source of problem behaviour'

Fear is easily installed in animal behaviour, but it is notoriously difficult to erase. The most effective and kindest way to deal with it is to use what's called 'de-sensitisation and counter conditioning'.

The dog is persuaded to gradually see the object of their fear as something good. It's done through associations (back to 'A' predicts 'B'). If every time your dog sees the scary thing, they get lavished with praise, happy talk, tasty treats or a valued toy, over time, they will start to see it as a positive thing instead. Your dog doesn't have to do anything in these cases. It just happens. The appearance of the scary thing reliably predicts good stuff.

If you are concerned about your dog's behaviour in any way, please contact a dog trainer or behaviourist to help you before things get out of control.

Bunnings Shirley BBQ Fundraiser

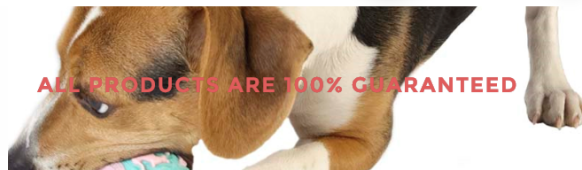
